

TERTIARY STUDENT GRANTS 2012

In 2012, procedures introduced in 2010 for adjudicating these awards were continued. The number of applicants improved from most institutions.

25 grants totalling \$20,000 were awarded in 2012, varying from \$500 to \$1,000. In addition, one \$1000 grant deferred from 2011 was made available, upon re-enrolment.
